Since 2003, Howell school custodians have saved Howell Public Schools over \$900,000 by taking concessions in wages, hours, and benefits. Yet, the district wants to privatize their jobs.

During current bargaining, custodians have offered an additional \$242,000 in savings, including:

- **A \$2,400 yearly health insurance contribution**

for a total of **\$1,147,000** over 4 years. Yet, the District still wants to privatize their jobs.
